MSSA provides an opportunity for students and community groups to share quality project ideas at Maryland's service-learning conference. Students showcase projects through Service Fair exhibits while community organizations offer opportunities for student involvement through the Resource Fair.

All exhibits are on display throughout the entire day so attendees can draw upon this valuable information and you can share your expertise. At a minimum, we ask you to have at least one person staff your table at all times. Your presence is important so you can answer questions and provide insight about your exhibit.

Your display should be no more than 4' x 3' in size and able to fit on a tabletop. We encourage freestanding, three-panel, poster board displays that clearly demonstrate the scope and positive impact of your service-learning project or opportunity through photos, news clippings, student reflections, and artwork. Handouts are also appropriate. If you need access to an electrical outlet, you may request it but MSSA cannot guarantee that your request will be filled. Please be prepared to adjust your display as appropriate.

To register as an Exhibitor, complete and return this form to MSSA by **January 16, 2004**. A table registration fee of \$15.00 (includes one 6-foot table and registration for two exhibitors) is required. Additional exhibitors are required to pay the registration fee of \$15.00 each. Payment is not due until you are confirmed. You must complete one form for each display. Space is limited and will be given on a first-come, first-served basis. MSSA will confirm your participation in February of 2004. ***Please be sure to complete the form in its entirety as incomplete forms will not be accepted.***
